## **Emergency Response Plan**

(Bonney Lake, WA) - With much careful thought and consideration, the Bonney Lake
Food Bank has decided to move to an emergency response plan that will address the growing
need in our community for our services in these precarious times. With increased demand
doubling and a projection of increasing by six times in the coming months, we have opted to
switch to a twice a month Emergency Relief Food Distribution model. Our first drop will be
Saturday March 28th. We are putting our operations on pause for the week of March 23rd
through the 27th while we gather a client roster via an appointment link on our website. We
will then produce dry boxes of supplemental, nutritious foods. With grocery donations of meat,
eggs, milk, and cheese rapidly declining we have opted to use community funding to purchase
locally sourced fresh foods to ensure we have plenty to feed all in need. On distribution day we
will have clients arrive at a predetermined time window, using an outdoor format to promote
social distancing and utmost precaution. We thank you all for your amazing response to the
rising need to feed more and more neighbors facing food insecurity in these trying times.
